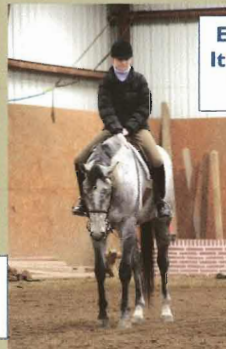

BUTTE SPECIAL RIDERS

BSR is composed of about 50 kids, each special in his/her own way. They spend their entire week looking forward to Monday mornings, when they meet with their best friends, including Christopher Robin, Bubbles, Oreo, Chipmunk & Minnie. These horses help each of these children through hippotherapy, a treatment using the horse's movements to provide carefully graded sensory input to improve neurological function and sensory input for children with conditions such as Down's Syndrome, Autism, Cerebral Palsy and other learning disabilities.



In late April, our volunteers took horses and riders to the Special Olympics in Bozeman. On June 1, BSR will hold their 2009 summer training at KHC. Volunteering is a fulfilling, heart-warming way to give back to your community; if you are interested in being a volunteer, contact Joani Kiscock or Nancy Ostle.
